

Preschool Center

Visual Arts


The Art Program at BCCA is designed so each student can explore and nurture their God-given artistic ability. Our elementary program is created in a dual-format of Foundations and Application Art. This format develops and builds upon each student’s ability and skill level in the production of projects in varying art categories. Middle and high school art is designed to further develop the student-artist’s skills in a discipline they are interested in such as drawing, calligraphy, painting, sculpture, and more.

Musical Arts

The Music Program at BCCA centers around creating an enjoyable atmosphere to learn and perform music to the glory of God. Students learn everything from the classical greats of the past to the newest songs on Christian radio today. In addition, students learn about reading music, keeping the beat using rhythm instruments, proper singing techniques, musical games, and so much more! The learning is utilized by participating in musical collaborations throughout the year.

Bergen County Christian Academy recognizes the vital role that technology contributes as a component of instruction. Just as it is a key component in our everyday lives, from getting the latest news, to the latest schedule of events, students today are experts at using all forms of technological resources. Technology plays an ever-increasing role in our lives as well as those of our children. Today, Internet resources, social media, as well as electronic communications of all forms, have become a de facto staple of everyday activities for our students.

Our department has courses that cover 15 different areas of media/technology in that students can participate in to grow their skills. Elementary students are taught fundamental computer skills. Middle & High School students build off of these skills to cover areas, which include Media Literacy, Video Editing, Graphic Design, Web Design, Social Media, and Online Journalism. With all Media/Technology courses, the goal is for all students to finish with a portfolio of video projects. All students in these courses will utilize our new Technology Lab which houses the 2021 M1 iMac.

Throughout the year our hallways and classrooms are busy with activity.
